PHYSICAL SUPPORT SCHEME

LSC is delighted to announce the creation of the LSC Physical Support Scheme which will commence in September 2022.

Injury management will be available to all students in-house. The new scheme will provide a holistic system for treating, rehabilitating and managing all students' injuries.

Treatments available:

Where clinically indicated the scheme will give students unlimited access to appointments (osteopathy, physiotherapy, tissue therapy, strength & conditioning and Pilates), for injury assessment and treatment and rehabilitation. Up to 50 appointments will be available each week, during term time.

The Physical Support Scheme will offer additional services where clinically indicated and at the discretion of the Head of Student Welfare (HoSW). These could include, but are not limited to:

- Imaging (MRI / X-ray / DEXA / Ultrasound) usually £120-£1,000
- Orthopaedic consultations usually in excess of £250
- Eating disorder dietetic support usually £75 per session
- Vocal health support usually £75 per session
- Gastroenterology consultation usually in excess of £250
- Dermatology consultation usually in excess of £250
- Respiratory services consultation usually in excess of £250
- Endocrinology assessment & consultation usually £290

How it will work:

Students will book in to see the HoSW who will make an initial assessment of the injury or condition. The HoSW will refer the student to the practitioner most appropriate to their injury needs.

The HoSW will work closely with the multi-disciplinary team of practitioners to monitor the student's progress.

The benefits:

There will be no requirement for a GP referral, no long wait for treatment and no admin associated with cash plans and insurance schemes.

Students who may not have had the financial means to access support for injury will now have inhouse access.

Students will be guided through their injury journey from the moment of injury through to full dance participation, using the skills of our expert practitioners.

What it will cost:

There will be an annual fee of £150 which will be separately itemised on the annual invoice and included in the first instalment payment for the academic year. This fee is not eligible for discount.
